AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 36-2161, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING SECTION 36-2163, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ABORTION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Section 36-2161, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. Section 36-2163, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
5 read:

6 36-2163. Reports; confidentiality; annual statistical report;
7 violations; classification; unprofessional
8 conduct; penalties

9 A. A report required by this article shall not contain the name of
10 the woman, common identifiers such as the woman's social security number,
11 driver license number or insurance carrier identification numbers or any
12 other information or identifiers that would make it possible to identify
13 in any manner or under any circumstances an individual who has obtained or
14 seeks to obtain an abortion.

15 B. The department of health services shall collect all abortion
16 reports, complication reports and informed consent reports and prepare a
17 comprehensive annual statistical report based on the data gathered in the
18 reports. The statistical report shall include a breakdown of the number
19 of abortions by gestational age of the unborn child at the time of the
20 abortion and the type of procedure performed or prescribed. ~~The
21 statistical report shall include a breakdown by month of the reasons for
22 abortions pursuant to section 36-2161 and a breakdown by month of the
23 number of abortions performed or prescribed by each hospital and facility
24 pursuant to section 36-2161.~~ All data included on the forms pursuant to
25 sections ~~36-2161~~, 36-2162 and 36-2162.01 shall be included in the
26 statistical report, except that the department shall confidentially
27 maintain the data that alone or in combination may constitute information
28 from which an individual performing or having an abortion may be
29 identified using epidemiologic principles. The statistical report shall
30 not lead to the disclosure of the identity of any person filing a report
31 or about whom a report is filed. The department shall make the
32 statistical report available on its website and for public inspection and
33 copying.

34 C. The statistical report prepared by the department pursuant to
35 subsection B of this section shall include statistics from the
36 administrative office of the courts containing the following information:

37 1. The number of petitions filed pursuant to section 36-2152,
38 subsection B.

39 2. Of the petitions filed pursuant to section 36-2152, subsection
40 B, the number in which the judge appointed a guardian ad litem or
41 court-appointed counsel for the minor pursuant to section 36-2152,
42 subsection D.

43 3. Of the petitions filed pursuant to section 36-2152, subsection
44 B, the number in which the judge issued an order authorizing an abortion
45 without parental consent.

1 4. Of the petitions filed pursuant to section 36-2152, subsection
2 B, the number in which the judge issued an order denying the petition.

3 5. Of the petitions denied, the number appealed to the court of
4 appeals.

5 6. The number of those appeals that resulted in the denials being
6 affirmed.

7 7. The number of those appeals that resulted in the denial being
8 reversed.

9 D. The statistical report prepared by the department pursuant to
10 subsection B of this section shall include statistics from the Arizona
11 health care cost containment system containing the following information:

12 1. The total number of abortions partially or fully paid for with
13 state monies through the Arizona health care cost containment system.

14 2. The total amount of state monies used to pay for the abortions
15 and expenses incidental to the abortions.

16 3. The total number of abortions, if any, paid for with state
17 monies and performed out of state.

18 E. Except for a statistical report as provided in subsection B of
19 this section, a report filed pursuant to this article is not a public
20 record and is not available for public inspection, except that disclosure
21 may be made to law enforcement officials on an order of a court after
22 application showing good cause. The court may condition disclosure of the
23 information on any appropriate safeguards it may impose.

24 F. Original copies of all reports filed pursuant to ~~sections~~
25 ~~36-2161 and SECTION~~ 36-2162 shall be available to the Arizona medical
26 board and the Arizona board of osteopathic examiners in medicine and
27 surgery for use in the performance of their official duties. The Arizona
28 medical board and the Arizona board of osteopathic examiners in medicine
29 and surgery shall maintain the confidentiality of any reports obtained
30 pursuant to this subsection.

31 G. An employee, agent or contractor of the department who wilfully
32 discloses any information obtained from reports filed pursuant to this
33 article, other than disclosure authorized under subsections B, E and F of
34 this section or as otherwise authorized by law, is guilty of a class 3
35 misdemeanor.

36 H. A person who is required by this article to file a report, keep
37 any records or supply any information and who wilfully fails to file that
38 report, keep records or supply information as required by law is guilty of
39 unprofessional conduct and is subject to discipline, including license
40 suspension or revocation.

41 I. A person who wilfully delivers or discloses to the department
42 any report, record or information known by that person to be false commits
43 a class 1 misdemeanor.

1 J. In addition to the penalties prescribed by subsections G, H and
2 I of this section, an organization or facility that wilfully violates the
3 reporting requirements of this article is subject to discipline by the
4 department, including the civil penalties prescribed in section
5 36-431.01. If an organization or facility that is licensed pursuant to
6 chapter 4, article 10 of this title wilfully violates the reporting
7 requirements of this article, the department may assess a civil penalty
8 pursuant to section 36-431.01, impose an intermediate sanction pursuant to
9 section 36-427, suspend or revoke a license pursuant to section 36-427,
10 deny a license or bring an action for an injunction pursuant to section
11 36-430.
